2. Amendment of Rule 28 (Entrance and Equipment Fees)

Rule 28(3): Sanctuary / National Park Entrance Fees

Category / Purpose	Target Group	Fee Structure
(a) Citizen of India • Photography • Tourism • Transaction of lawful business with a sanctuary resident	Individuals	Rs. 300/- per day for first 3 days; Rs. 500/- for every additional day after 3 days.
(b) Person other than a citizen of India • Photography • Tourism • Transaction of lawful business with a sanctuary resident	Individuals	Rs. 600/- per day for first 3 days; Rs. 1000/- for every additional day after 3 days.
(c) Students	Studying in school	Half the rate of fees mentioned in clause (a) or (b) as the case may be.
(d) Children	Below five years of age	No fee shall be payable.
(e) Vehicle Entry Levies	Light Vehicle Heavy Vehicle	Rs. 1000/- per day Rs. 2000/- per day

Rule 28(4)(a): Professional Camera Operation Fees

Camera Type	Category / Nationality	Fee Structure
Still Camera	Citizen of India	Rs. 625/- for first 3 days and Rs. 125/- for every additional day after 3 days.
	A person other than citizen of India	Rs. 1250/- for first 3 days and Rs. 250/- for every additional day after 3 days.
Cine Camera (i)	Citizen of India	Rs. 12,500/- for first 3 days and Rs. 18,500/- for every additional day after 3 days.
Cine Camera (ii)	A person other than citizen of India	Rs. 25,000/- for first 3 days and Rs. 37,500/- for every additional day after 3 days.

Rule 28(4)(b): Film Shooting Fees

S.No.	Type of Film / Agency	Rate per Day or Week
(i)	Feature film by private agency	Rs. 10000/- per day or Rs. 60000/- per week.
(ii)	Feature film by government agency	Rs. 6000/- per day or Rs. 35000/- per week.
(iii)	Documentary film by private agency	Rs. 6000/- per day or Rs. 30000/- per week.
(iv)	Documentary film by government agency	Rs. 4000/- per day or Rs. 20000/- per week.
(v)	For Home video	Rs. 2000/- per day or Rs. 10000/- per week.

Note: For a person other than citizen of India, where permitted, the fees shall be thrice the above in foreign currency at current rate prevalent.

Rule 28(4)(c): Drone Camera Fees

(Special permission for use of drones may be given by the Chief Wildlife Warden only for Citizens or Institutions of India for educational or research or publicity or awareness purposes)

S.No.	Agency Type	Fee Structure
(i)	Use of Drone Camera by Himachal Pradesh State Government or Agency	Rs. 10000/- per day for first 3 days and Rs. 15000/- for every additional day after 3 days.
(ii)	Use of Drone Camera by any other Government or Agency	Rs. 30000/- per day for first 3 days and Rs. 45,000/- for every additional day after 3 days.
(iii)	Use of Drone Camera by private agency or media house or NGO or freelance photographer or others	Rs. 50000/- per day for first 3 days and Rs. 75,000/- for every additional day after 3 days.

Terms and Conditions

1. Permission shall remain valid only for the specified period and area.
2. All provisions of the Wildlife (Protection) Act, 1972 and ESZ guidelines shall be strictly followed.
3. Drone operation shall not disturb wildlife or sensitive habitats.
4. Camping/tenting shall only be carried out at approved locations.
5. Littering and environmental degradation are strictly prohibited.
6. Carrying firearms, alcohol, narcotics, or explosives is prohibited.
7. No tree felling, lopping, or vegetation damage shall be allowed.
8. Open fire is prohibited except at designated locations.
9. Hunting, teasing, feeding, or disturbing wildlife is prohibited.
10. Permission may be cancelled in case of violation of conditions.
11. Forest/Wildlife staff instructions shall be complied with at all times.
12. Any damage caused shall be recovered as per rules.
